Discussion on the motion included: Ken Robb stated that he would prefer that Council solicit applicants to be reviewed for the vacant seat and that he did not appreciate that the majority resorted to the fact without any discussion on the appointment. Lou Bender stated that Joe Nagy was nominated due to his previous experience on Council. Ken Robb stated that this was designed ahead of time.

Kenneth Robb made a motion to approve Resolution of Council of the Borough of White Oak approving that the acquisition and subsequent disposition of numerous parcels of vacant property known as block and lot number <u>461-C-360</u> would be in accord with the Comprehensive Plan of our Municipality. (Note: This is in cooperation with the County of Allegheny and the Redevelopment Authority of Allegheny County as we are participating in the Allegheny County Vacant Property Program. Julie Opferman seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

Councilman Pambacas stated he wanted to clarify his vote for Joseph Nagy, he stated that there was no warning given and no discussion prior to the appointment vote. He does not discount Mr. Nagy's experience just not happy about how the appointment was handled.

Councilman Bender stated that given in March 2018 at 12:01am a previous resignation occurred and for the next two (2) Council Meetings certain members didn't attend, leading to no quorum for the meetings. This led to a vacancy and delayed proceedings.

Councilman Robb stated that Councilman Bender's appointment was questionable plus the sum of money you received from retiring form the Police Department.

Councilman Bender replied there are many different ways to appoint Council Members.

Councilman Pambacas replied he wants to see what is best for White Oak Borough, we need to look forward and not looking to what has occurred in the past. That is wrong plain and simple.
