Outdoor Burning**

1551.01 PROHIBITIONS.

No person shall cause, suffer or permit the outdoor burning of any material in any area with the Borough of White Oak, in such a manner that:

- (a) The emissions are visible at any time at the point such emissions pass outside the property of the person on whose land the open burning is being conducted;
- (b) Malodorous air contaminants from the open burning are detectable outside the property of the person on whose land the open burning is conducted;
- (c) The emissions interfere with the reasonable enjoyment of life or property.
- (d) The emissions cause damage to vegetation or property; or
- (e) The emissions are or may be deleterious to human health.

1551.02 EXCEPTIONS.

Nothing contained herein, however, shall prevent the operation of outdoor grilles or fireplaces for the preparation of food.

1551.03 MONITORING.

Outdoor burning, where permitted, shall be constantly attended by an adult at least eighteen years of age and shall be so attended until the fire is extinguished. No smoldering fires or smoldering burning is permitted.

1551.04 ENFORCEMENT; FINES.

The White Oak Borough Code Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized to enforce this Ordinance by the issue of citations. Violations of this Ordinance shall result in the following fines:

- (a) First offense: Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)
- (b) Second offense: Fifty dollars (\$50.00)
- (c) Third offense: One hundred dollars (\$100.00)
- (d) Fourth and additional offenses: Six hundred dollars (\$600.00)
